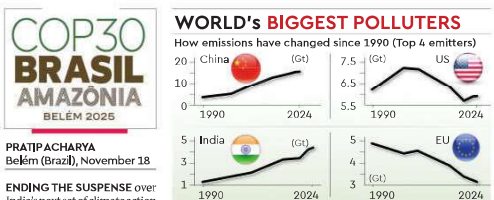

India's climate action plan for 2035 before year-end

ENDING THE SUSPENSE over India's next set of climate action plan, called Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) in climate jargon, Environment Minister Bhupendra Yadav said the country's NDCs for 2035 will be finalised and released before the year-end deadline.

Yadav was making a personal statement at the ongoing COP30 climate conference here. He said India had already achieved the targets it had set in its previous NDCs well ahead of schedule, setting an example for developed countries to follow.

Yadav said along with its 2035 NDCs, India would also release its first Biennial Transparency Report (BTR), as mandated under the Paris Agreement. BTRs are part of reporting mechanism introduced under the Paris Agreement, through which countries are supposed to periodically provide information about their greenhouse gas emissions inventory. "We are making progress in all the NDC targets, adaptation and other climate actions being undertaken, climate finance provided or received, other relevant issues like technology transfer and capacity building."

NDCs, on the other hand, are climate action plans that outline efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and adapt to climate change for the next 20 years. Countries are required to update them every five years with progressively higher tar-

India: Rich nations must hit net zero & pay up on climate

RICHER NATIONS must move faster on zeroing out emissions and do more to mobilise funding to help developing economies meet climate targets, Environment Minister Bhupendra Yadav told the COP30 summit in Brazil.

"Developed countries must reach net zero far earlier than current target dates of 2050," he said, adding that India will publish a new strategy for emissions reductions through 2035. Yadav said on Monday, according to a statement from the ministry.

India, the world's third-largest polluter, has long argued that industrialised nations should carry a greater decarbonisation burden and that still-developing countries require more assistance to simultaneously curb emissions and drive economic growth.

The country, which is targeting net zero by 2070 — two decades later than many major nations, and 10 years later than China — intends to publish a new strategy for emissions reductions through 2035. Yadav said in the statement, without specifying a date — **BLOOMBERG**

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its 2035 NDC at the COP30 event, but Yadav said there was still some time, and India would announce the plan after getting the clearance of the Cabinet.

"The process of formulating the updated NDC is underway at full scale. The entire plan will be submitted for Cabinet approval and then we will be announcing it. We are not late on any schedule since we have our time till December to announce the report," Yadav said. Yadav arrived in Belem on November 16 (Sunday) to kickstart the negotiations during the second and final week of COP30.

India to host a global big cats meet next year

Calling for renewed global cooperation to protect big cat species and their habitats as part of integrated climate and biodiversity action, Environment Minister Bhupendra Yadav on Monday announced India's decision to host a 'Global Big Cats Summit' in New Delhi next year.

Speaking at a high-level ministerial segment at COP30 conference focused on International Big Cats Alliance (IBCA), Yadav spoke about India's successes in the conservation and protection of big cat populations. India is the home to several big cats including Royal Bengal Tiger, Asiatic Lion, Indian Leopard and Clouded Leopard.

"India has been able to double its tiger population ahead of the target timeline and our Asiatic lion population continues to grow well. We (India) have built one of the world's most comprehensive wildlife databases through nationwide population assessments of tigers, lions, leopards and snow leopards, while expanding protected areas, securing corridors and partnering with local communities for conservation and eco-based livelihoods," he said.

Minor improvement for Indian universities in new QS rankings

● No Indian institute in top 200 this year

INDIAN UNIVERSITIES HAVE shown a minor improvement in the latest QS Sustainability Rankings 2026 with 32 out of the 103 in the global list moving up the rankings compared to the previous year. The number of universities which saw a drop in the rankings stood at 30 while 15 retained last year's rankings.

Among the 15 IITs that feature in the ranking this

year, six have seen lower rankings in 2026 compared to 2025. These include IIT Delhi, which topped the Indian group, slipping from

171 in 2025 to 205 in 2026. Similarly, IIT Bombay, the second-best ranked Indian institute, has dropped one spot to 235.

India is one of the four higher education systems which has more than 100 universities featuring in the sustainability rankings this year. The US has the highest number of universities (240) followed by China (163), the UK (109) and France (76).

"A total of eight locations saw at least 10 institutions debut in the ranking this year, with Mainland China with the most, with 49 debutants, followed by India with 26, France with 19 and Türkiye with 18," the QS said. QS methodology is based on university performance across three categories: the 24-hour average Air Quality Index (AQI) reading set at 374, up from 351 recorded on Monday, according to the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB). Data on the CPCB's Saran showed that 12 stations reported AQI levels in the 'severe' category on Tuesday, compared to only two on Monday. Punjab, Bihar, West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, and Sikkim.

No firm is immune if AI bubble bursts: Pichai

ALPHABET CHIEF EXECUTIVE Sundar Pichai said no company would be unaffected if the artificial intelligence boom collapses, as soaring valuations and heavy investment in the sector fuel concerns of a bubble.

Pichai said in an interview with the BBC published on Tuesday that the current wave of AI investment was an "extraordinary moment" but acknowledged "elements of irrationality" in the market.

Alphabet shares have surged about 46% this year, as investors bet on its ability to compete with ChatGPT-maker OpenAI.

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In September, Alphabet pledged \$5 billion over two years

for UK AI infrastructure and research, including a new data centre and investment in DeepMind, its London-based AI lab.

Pichai told the BBC in the interview conducted at Google's California headquarters that Google would begin training models like Gemini, which it says it hopes will bolster the company's ambition to be the world's third AI "superpower".

Delhi's air quality in 'very poor' category

THE AIR QUALITY in Delhi stayed in the 'very poor' category for the fifth consecutive day on Tuesday. The pollution measure in the previous day's level, with air quality recordings in over 10 monitoring stations slipping into the 'severe' category, a level known to pose health risks even to otherwise healthy people.
